As part of it's Race To The Top Plan

the Brandywine School District is implementing a new core curriculum for all students grades K through 12.

Michelle Kutch with the district says some material may be taught at different grade levels than they are now and consistency will be emphasized so a rigorous education will be had in every building.

Also math lessons are going to look a little different as the district adopts Singapore math.

"What we've seen with Singapore math is just a really great and logical way of presenting this material to kids," Kutch said. "That they really get a sense of understanding their basic skills."
