Our students have been doing especially well in two key match areas: multiplication and geometry. For multiplication, we've been using our quick response boards (erasable withle boards) to practice our boards (erasable with boards) and the way from 1 to 30 Weve also started geometry and figuring out how to measure mathematical shapes. We can calculate the perimeter of a rectangle, which is the distance around the outside, as well as its area, the size of a shape's surface. Tyn's Eellman (right) shows off his perfect area problems which Ms. Smith has prominently displayed in the classroom.
