Revo Academy, a gifted learner school for kindergartners through eighth-graders, will host an open house from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Sun., June 14 at Temple Etz Chaim, 1080 E. Janss Road, Thousand Oaks.

The academy will open Tues., Sept. 1 from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. weekdays, following Conejo Valley Unified School District's academic calendar.

Revo was founded by educators with an expertise in gifted education. Subject areas are taught using in-depth inquiry and project-based lessons to provide for appropriate academic challenge and a sense of accomplishment.

the Gifted and Talented," said Tamy Aberson-Sloboda, co-founder of Revo Academy.


"The curriculum is based on proven practices from the leading gifted program developers around the country, including the William and

Mary College of Gifted Education, University of Connecticut Neag Center for Gifted and Talented Education and Singapore Math, meeting the needs (of) gifted and talented students," said the cofounder. The Revo program provides enrichment classes in art, foreign language, academic chess, Odyssey of the Mind, service learning, physical education and field trips.

Academy teachers are fully credentialed with master's degrees and training and expertise in gifted education.

Class size is a ratio of 15:2, with one credentialed teacher and one teacher's assistant in each
